+ 6. The samurai reached the peak of importance and influence during the civil wars of the 16th century when they fought for warlords.

+ 8. In 1867 when the last shogun called Tokugawa Keiki resigned, Japan began modernising military forces, thus in 1872 the conscription appeared and the western army structure was introduced.

- 9. As a result, the samurai were no longer needed or wanted, so remaining samurai in Satsuma decided to mount rebellion against the government.

- + 10. The Satsuma rebellion turned out to be a disaster for the samurai that were finally defeated by ^{the} Imperial Army in 1877
