1. The samurai worked for shogun during the wartime, but in peace they were employed by large landowners - so called "daimyo".
2. Being samurai gave many privileged rights such as carrying swords and riding horses.
3. But of course there was an exchange for those rights: the samurai owed absolute loyalty to their daimyo, including even committing suicide when daimyo died.

4. This tradition was a part of "bushido" or "the way of the warrior" and meant respecting the strict code of honour: being stress-stable, self-disciplined and brave.
5. Bushido was based on peaceful beliefs of Zen Buddhism, but despite this the samurai became the most ruthless, feared and brutal warriors in Asia.
6. The samurai reached their peak of importance and influence during the civil wars that took place in 16th century when they fought for rival warlords.
7. Peaceful years began after 1603 and so the samurai gradually lost their military importance and many of them became administrators instead of soldiers.
8. As the last shogun Tokugawa Keiki resigned in 1867, Japan began to modernise ^{its} military forces and eventually introduced conscription and western army structure in 1872.
9. As a result the samurai were no longer needed and wanted, so the remaining samurai of Satsuma decided to mount rebellion against the government.
10. Satsuma rebellion was a disaster for samurai and after all they were finally defeated by the Imperial Army in 1877.
