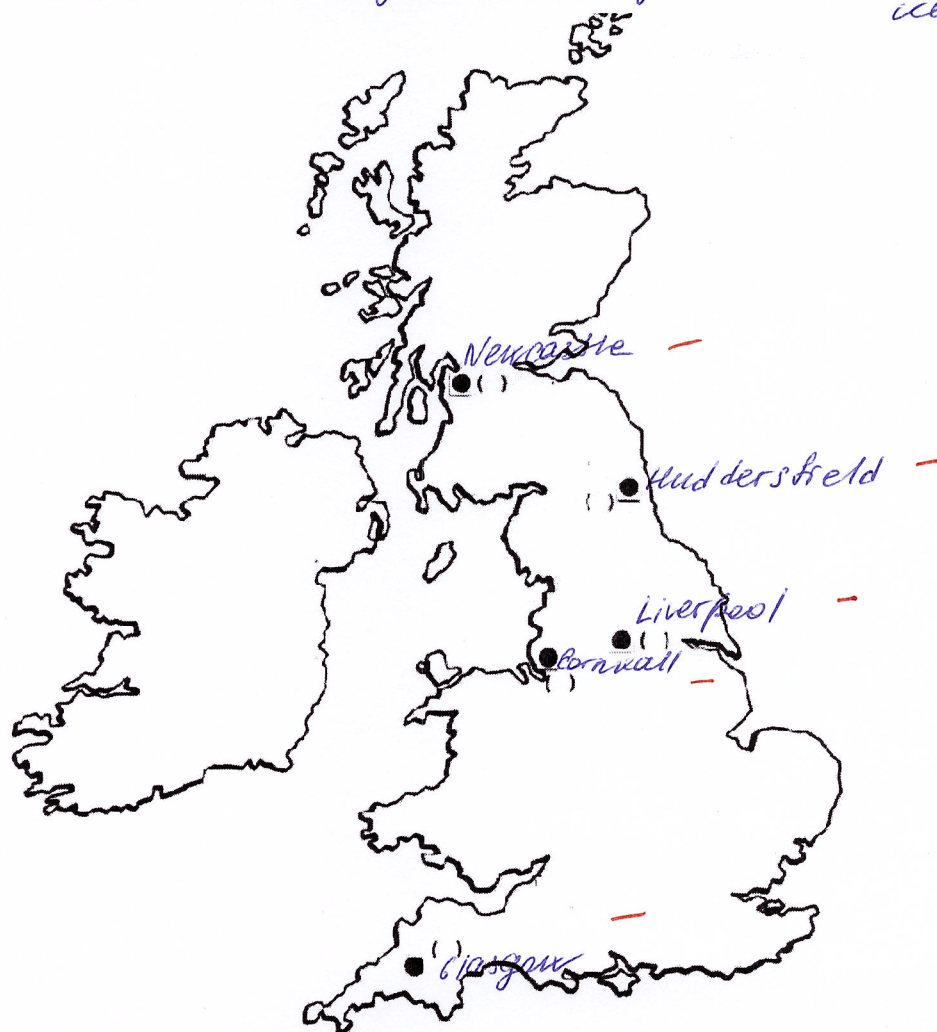
2 To let the friend use the speaker's cellphone but with the idea of her paying extra minutes she takes for talking to her boyfriend.
