✗ People: warm-hearted, hospitable, suspicious of strangers, the accent's a bit of elishay

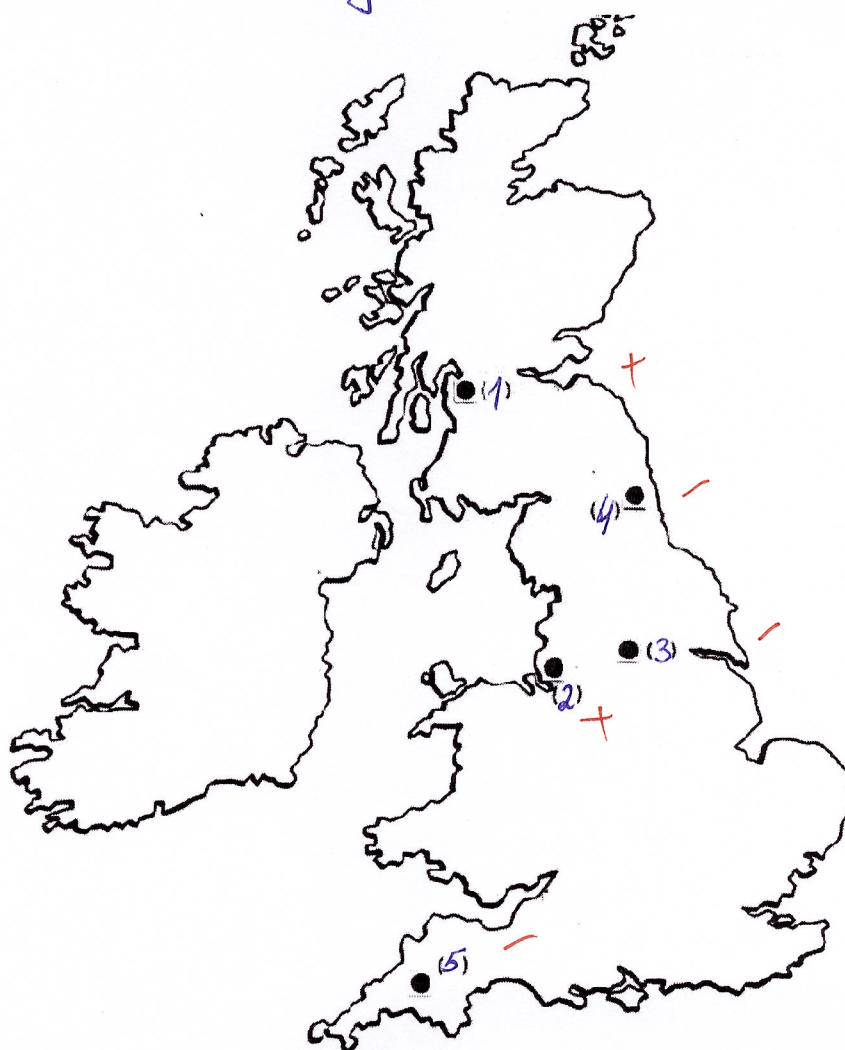
✗ Weather: mixed, very good or wet
