CRIMINOLOGY IN LITERATURE

Criminology is the study of crime and criminal behavior on the basis of principles of sociology and other non-legal fields such as psychology, economics, statistics, and anthropology.

Criminologists are the people working and researching the study of crime and society's reaction to crime. Some criminologists examine types of criminals' behavior. Generally, criminologists carry out research and investigations and develop special theories.

The interests of criminologists include the study of nature of crime and criminals, origins of criminal law, social reaction to crime.

A crime lab is a scientific laboratory which uses primarily forensic science for the purpose of examining evidence from criminal cases. In a typical crime lab the following professionals work: field analysts (investigators that go to crime scenes to collect evidence), forensic evidence technicians, crime scene investigators, lab analysts (scientists or other personnel who run tests on the evidence if it is brought to the lab, for example, DNA tests).

This subject was described in different detective stories by thousands of writers. One of them is Agatha Mary Clarissa Christie. She was an English writer known for her 66 detective novels and 14 short story collections, particularly those revolving around fictional detectives Hercule Poirot and Miss Marple. Agatha Christie has been called the "Queen of Crime'. She is listed as the best-selling fiction writer of all time, her novels having sold more than two billion copies.

Christie was born into a wealthy upper middle class family and got education at home. She was initially an unsuccessful writer, but this situation changed in 1920 when *The Mysterious Affair at Styles* was published. Her first husband was Archibald Christie; they married in 1914 and had one child before divorcing in 1928. During both World Wars, she served in hospital **dispensaries**, acquiring a thorough knowledge of the poisons that **featured** in many of her novels, short stories, and plays. After her marriage to archeologist Max Mallowan in 1930, she spent several months each year **on digs** in the Middle East and used her first-hand knowledge of this profession in her books. Agatha Christie remains the most-translated individual author. Many of Christie's books and short stories have been adapted for television, radio, video games, and graphic novels. More than 30 films are based on her work.

NIGHT SHIFTS

Working at night is quite a controversial issue. Some prefer working night shifts, others hate this practice but due to certain reasons they do not have any choice, those professionals whose jobs involve emergency services (i.e. doctors, nurses, police officers, firemen) have to work at night. Evenings and nights are the busiest time for hospitals, so there is a strong demand for doctors and nurses work at night.

Besides emergency services there are such jobs as taxi drivers, hotel receptionists, veterinary technicians, warehouseemployees, janitors, flight attendants.

Night shift work increases the risk of developing diabetes, heart disease, and obesity. It disrupts the body's 24-hour internal "clock" that controls when you sleep and wake. Night shift is likely to have an impact on one's health. In fact, in some cases, night workers experience a higher risk with metabolism and sleeping issues. At the same time due to fewer visitors, telephone calls, etc. working overnight can result in a quieter workplace.

To avoid health disorders or at least lower the risk one should prepare for the night shift: use your sunglasses if walking home; where possible, work in bright light; get nine-seven hours of sleep every 24 hours – even if it's broken sleep; plan, prepare and bring your own healthy food to work; drink enough water.

It is important to try to ensure that you sleep well following the night shift, especially if you work every day. It is advisable to go to sleep soon after returning home, otherwise external stimuli such as sun light, are likely to keep you awake for longer.

Advantages of working at night: you will make more money – most companies pay a premium to their employees for working the night shift; enhanced sense of comradeship; fewer distractions and disruptions; opportunities to build one's skillset; less competition; reducedcommute time; more hours in the day; time to pursue further education.


