You have to be vigilant for opportunists who might try to steal them." He added that: "Thieves used to target 'Rolex' watches with which go for thousands of pounds and then sell them online." A London transport spokesperson said: "Canada goose coats are targeted for robbery. It's a real concern to us because it really impacts the safety of young people on the network." She added that this "acquisitive crime" was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening".
