### Task 3.

There has been a spate of magazines in cities across the globe as maggas are focusing on a new item to steal — luxury coats. In recent weeks, people in London, Washington D.C. and all the metropolitan areas have been robbed of the coats at knife point. Man in Birmingham in the UK was





across his face as thieves made off with his jacket.

"Kanada goose coats are targeted for robbery. It's a real concern to us because it really impacts the safety of young people on the network." She added that this "a ~~qu~~isative crime" was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening."
