There has been a spike of mugging in cities across the globe, as ~~images~~ muggers are focusing on a new item to steal - luxury coats. One man in Birmingham in the jockey was slashed across his face as thieves made off with his jacket. Criminals are targeting coats that cost as much as \$2,200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats off people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham city





university, warned that muggings were the start of a new "luxury-crime trend". He said the thieves were "waring".
