A London transport spokesperson said: "Canada goose coats are targeted for robbery. It's a real concern to us because it really impacts the safety of young people on the network". She added this "agressive crime" was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening".

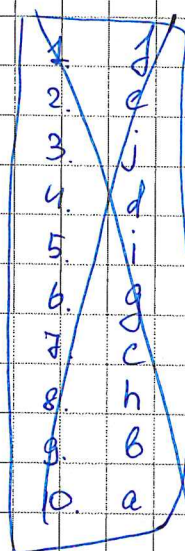
