One man in Birmingham in the UK was slashed across his face as ~~thiever~~ thieves made off with his jacket.

Criminals are targeting coats that cost as much as \$ 2200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats off people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. ~~Proffe~~ Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham City University, warned that the muggings



were the start of a new "luxury crime trend." He said the thefts were "worrying."

Professor Wilson warned those with high-end winter jackets to be careful. He said: "I would tell anyone wearing Canada Goose Branded jackets to be careful and be aware of your surroundings and who is around you.
