There has been a spate of muggings in cities across the globe as muggers are focusing on a new item to steal - luxury coats. In recent weeks, people in London, Washington DC and other metropolitan areas have been robbed of their coats at knife point. One man in Birmingham in the UK was slashed across his face as thieves made off with his jacket. Criminals are targeting coats that cost as much as \$2,200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats of people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham city university, warned that the muggings were the start of a new "luxury crime trend". He said the thefts were "worrying".





Professor Wilson warned those with high-end winter jackets to be careful. He said "I would tell anyone wearing Canada Goose branded jackets to be careful and be aware of your surroundings and who is around you. She added that this "acquisitive crime" was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening".
