Task 8

Social networks are popular these days. Almost three quarters of teens have an account in a social network. There are reasons for this high rate.

First of all, networks are a convenient way of communication, especially in troubled times of COVID-19. Teenagers can meet like-minded people around the world. The average teen has 201 Facebook friends—I doubt they are all from the teen's hometown! Social networks are also a source of information.

But it is not always true. 25% of Facebook users are under younger than 10. They are easily misguided and gullible, so parents should check who their children are chatting with.
