There has been a spate of margins in cities across the globe as marges are focusing on a new item to steal - luxury coats. In recent weeks, people in London, Washington D.C. and other metropolitan areas have been robbed off their





coats at naive point. One man in Birmingham in the juckie was slashed across his face as thieves made off with his jacket. Criminals are targeting coats that cost as much as \$2,200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats off people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham City University, warned that the margins were the state of a new "luxury crimetrend". He said the thefts were "waring".

Professor Wilson warned those with high-end winter jackets to be careful. He said: "I would tell anyone wearing Canada Goose branded jackets to be careful and be aware of your surroundings and who is around you. She added that this "acquisitive crime" was very concerning, intimidating and frightening".
