Mr. Bezos' thoughts are echoed by fellow multi-billionaire Elon Musk, owner of X (formerly known as Twitter). Earlier this year, Mr. Musk warned that: "Population collapse due to low birth rates is a much bigger risk to civilization than global warming ... Mark these words." Mr. Bezos conceives of people living in giant space stations. He said most inhabitants of these would visit Earth for vacations. He envisions our planet returning to its pristine environment, as factories would exploit resources on the Moon or on asteroids instead of using up Earth's.
