Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham City University, warned that the murgings were the start of a new "luxury crimetrend". He said the thefts were "worrying".

try to steal them." He added that: "Thieves used to target Rolex watches which go for thousands of pounds ~~£~~ and then sell them online." She added that this 'acquisitive crime' was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening".
