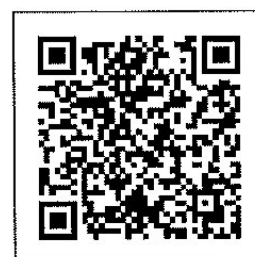

You have to be vigilant for opportunists who might try to steal them." He added that: "Thieves used to target rolex watches with gear for thousands of pounds and then sell them on line." A London transport spokes person said: "Canada goose coats are targeted for robbery. It's a real concern to us because it really impacts the safety of young people on the network." She added that this "acquisitive crime" was very concerning, intimidating and frightening.
