ham in the UK was slashed across his face as thieves made off with his jacket. Criminals were targeting coats that cost as much as \$2,200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats of people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. Professor David Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham city university, warned that muggings were the start of a new "luxury crime trend". He said, the thieves were "varying".

It's a real concern to us because it really impact impacts the safety of young people on the network". She added that this "acquisitive crime" was "very concerning, intimidating and frightening".
