One man in Birmingham in the UK was slashed across his face as thieves made off with his



jacket. Criminals are targeting coats that cost as much as \$2,200 each. As well as literally stealing the coats off people's backs, thieves are breaking into people's vehicles. Professor Wilson, a criminologist at Birmingham City University, warned that the muggings were the state of a new "luxury-crime trend". He said that the thieves were "worrying".
