There has been a spate of ~~major~~ muggings in cities ~~are~~ across the globe as muggers are focusing on a new item to steal - luxury coats. Professor David Willson, a criminologist at Birmingham City University, warned that the muggings were the start of a new "luxury crimetrend". He said the ~~thieves~~ thefts were "worrying".

Professor Willson warned those with high-end winter jackets to be careful.
