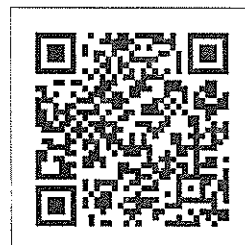

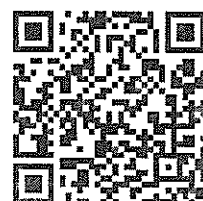

Tom got into the wooden boat. They continued going down the river.

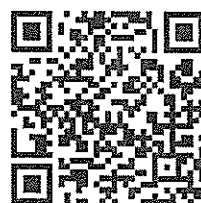
- Ed, look what I found! - Tom pulled a bunch of golden coins out of his pocket.
