Audience: pupils, students, professors, teachers, lovers of history, tutors.

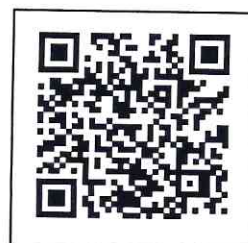
Features: old words, which are not used nowadays. A lot of dates and a rich portrait of the past.
