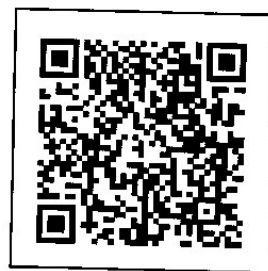

Paragraph 6.

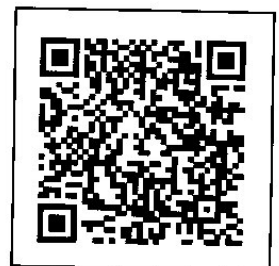
In his mind, the doubtful voice whispered excuses, but Oliver answered: "Why are you always sabotaging my desire to be

4. Slow, unorganised, failing to deliver expected results with consistency and/or quality.

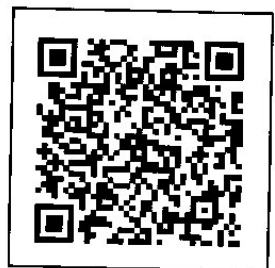
