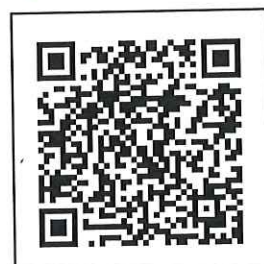

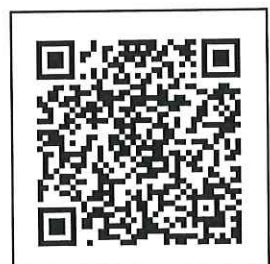




a winner in front of the whole school
